FULL TUTORIAL: CRAFTING THE CUSTEM PATCHWORK BASKET

MATERIALS & PREPARATION

FABRIC FAT QUARTERS
ASSORTED SMALL FABRICS

COTTON BATTING
HEAVY THREAD

LEATHER HANDLES (2 x 35 CM)
INTERFACING
SEWING NOTIONS

CUTTING GUIDE & LAYOUT

MAIN BODY PANEL
84 CM x 25 CM

INNER LINING PANEL
(64 CM x 25 CM)

BATTING PANEL
(64 CM x 25 CM)

FLORAL PANEL C
25 CM x 25 CM

BINDING STRIP
(5 CM)

e.g. 5 T wide x 210 CM for all edges

STEP 1: PIECE THE EXTERIOR

STEP 2: CREATE THE QUILTED

EXTERIOR
PINNERS
LINING
BATTING

STEP 3: M-MACHINE QUILTING & A-HAND QUILTING

SEED STITCH
STITCH-IN-THE-DITCH
A-SIMPLE BIG-STITCH

STEP 4: ASSEMBLE BASKET BODY

FLAT-FELLED SEAM

STEP 5: BIND TOP EDGE & ATTACH HANDLES

HAND SEWN

KEY US QUILTING & SEWING METHODS

- Piecework**
Sewing small fabric scraps together to create a larger pattern.
- Quilting**
Joining fabric layers with stitches for warmth and texture.
- Binding**
A technique to encase raw fabric edges with a separate strip.
- Machine Piecing**
Quick, precise construction using a sewing machine.
- Hand Quilting**
Adding texture and character with visible hand stitches.
- Appliqué**
Attaching a separate fabric shape onto a larger piece.
- Quilt-As-You-Go (optional)**
An alternative method where you quilt small.

Creating your own patchwork basket is a rewarding sewing project that combines quilting techniques with practical design. This step-by-step guide will walk you through everything—from selecting materials to finishing touches—so anyone in the U.S. (even beginners with basic sewing skills) can successfully complete it.

Materials & Preparation

Before you begin, gather all your supplies to ensure a smooth workflow:

- Fabric fat quarters (main prints and coordinating fabrics)
- Assorted small fabric scraps (for patchwork sections)
- Cotton batting
- Interfacing (medium to heavy weight for structure)
- Heavy-duty thread
- Standard sewing thread
- Sewing notions (pins, scissors, ruler, chalk, etc.)
- Leather handles (2 pieces, approx. 14 inches / 35 cm each)
- Sewing machine
- Hand sewing needle

Choose fabrics that complement each other. A mix of floral, geometric, and solid prints works beautifully for a balanced patchwork design.

Cutting Guide & Layout

Accurate cutting is key to a polished result. Use a quilting ruler and rotary cutter if possible.

Cut the following pieces:

- Main body panel: 25" x 10" (64 cm x 25 cm)
- Inner lining panel: 25" x 10" (64 cm x 25 cm)
- Batting panel: 25" x 10" (64 cm x 25 cm)
- Bottom circle: 8" diameter (20 cm)
- Binding strips: 2" wide (5 cm), total length approx. 82" (210 cm)

For patchwork:

- Cut small squares and triangles (approx. 3" / 7 cm each side)
- Arrange them into a visually pleasing layout before sewing

Take time to plan your layout—this is where your creativity shines ✨

Step 1: Piece the Exterior

Start by sewing your patchwork panel:

- Arrange your fabric pieces (triangles, squares, rectangles)
- Sew pieces together in rows using a ¼ inch seam allowance
- Press seams flat after each step

- Continue joining rows until you reach the full panel size

Add a central decorative strip (like a floral panel) for a professional look.

Ensure your final panel matches the required dimensions.

Step 2: Create the Quilted Panel

Now it's time to layer and quilt:

- Place batting on the bottom
- Add your patchwork exterior on top (right side facing up)
- Place lining fabric underneath if doing quilt-as-you-go

Pin all layers securely.

Quilting options:

- Stitch-in-the-ditch (along seam lines)
- Straight-line quilting
- Light decorative stitching

This step adds structure and durability.

Step 3: Machine & Hand Quilting

Enhance your basket with quilting details:

- Use your sewing machine for main quilting lines
- Add hand quilting (optional) for texture and charm
- Try big-stitch quilting with thicker thread for a modern look

Focus on securing all layers evenly without puckering.

Step 4: Assemble Basket Body

Turn your flat panel into a cylindrical shape:

- Fold the quilted panel right sides together
- Sew the side seam using a strong stitch
- Press seam open or to one side
- Optionally, use a flat-felled seam for extra durability

Turn the piece right side out—you'll now see the basket form!

Step 5: Bind Top Edge & Attach Handles

Finish the top edge neatly:

- Attach binding strip around the top edge
- Fold over and stitch in place (machine or hand sew)

Attach handles:

- Position handles evenly on opposite sides (about 5 inches apart)
- Use heavy-duty thread for strength
- Reinforce with extra stitching or rivets if desired

This step combines both function and style.

Step 6: Attach the Base

Now close the bottom:

- Pin the circular base to the bottom opening
- Match edges carefully and distribute evenly
- Sew slowly around the circle

After stitching:

- Turn basket right side out
- Push base outward to create a flat bottom

Your basket should now stand upright on its own!
