- #4 Worsted Weight Cotton
- #4 Yarn Weight
- #3 Worsted Weights
- #4 Worsted Weight Cotton
- H/8 (5mm)
- J/10 (6mm)
- Hook Size available: H/8 (5mm) and J/10 (6mm)
- Scissors
- Tapestry Needle

KEY STITCHES & METHODS (US TERMS)




Ch (Chain)
Initial foundational loops and ween crow their loop.




Sc (Single Crochet)
Basic compact stitch. how coner-kongle single stitch.




Hdc (Half-Double Crochet)
Slightly taller stitch. The emst thronor stitch out of the necklacte.




Dc (Double Crochet)
Tall, common stitch. Tall reanioraw the tall common stitch.




Tr (Treble Crochet)
Very tall, textured stitch. to thear textured stitch off the puff stitch.



Puff Stitch (Detailed)
Step-by-step illustrations, yo, insert, draw up loop, repeat 3x, yo, draw through all yo, draw through all) to create the signature teardrop shape.



Magic Ring (or Adjustable Loop)
Start technique for the central modala for the central mandala.



Chainless Foundation (Ch-Fdc or Ch-Sc)
Chainless Foundation (alternative start for the neck strap.

Part 1: Central Mandala Base (Sage Green & Goldenrod)


Magic Ring

Round 1
Tr stitches in Sage (33 stitches)

(Tr stitches in Sage)



Part 2: Terracotta Lattice (Sc, Ch, and Picot)



This Terracotta border forms how V-shape town chain spaces and picots for texture.


Part 3: Integrated Tassels (Puff Stitches)



Materials You Will Need

- Worsted weight cotton yarn (#4) in three colors:
 - Terracotta
 - Sage Green
 - Goldenrod
- Crochet hook sizes:
 - H/8 (5 mm)
 - J/10 (6 mm)
- Scissors 
- Tapestry needle



Abbreviations (US Terms)

- Ch = Chain
- Sc = Single Crochet
- Hdc = Half Double Crochet
- Dc = Double Crochet
- Tr = Treble Crochet
- Yo = Yarn Over
- Sl st = Slip Stitch



Key Techniques to Know

Chain (Ch)

This creates your foundation. Yarn over and pull through the loop on your hook.

Single Crochet (Sc)

Insert hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through both loops.

Half Double Crochet (Hdc)

Yarn over, insert hook, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through all loops.

Double Crochet (Dc)

Yarn over, insert hook, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops, yarn over, pull through remaining 2 loops.

Treble Crochet (Tr)

Yarn over twice, insert hook, pull up a loop, yarn over and pull through 2 loops three times.

Puff Stitch (for Tassels)

- Yarn over, insert hook, pull up a loop
- Repeat 3 times (you'll have multiple loops)
- Yarn over and pull through all loops
- Chain to secure

Magic Ring

Wrap yarn into a loop, insert hook, pull up a loop, then crochet into the ring.

Chainless Foundation

Alternative to starting chains, creating a more flexible base for straps.

Part 1: Central Mandala Base

Start with **Sage Green yarn**

Round 1

- Create a magic ring
- Work **33 treble crochets (Tr)** into the ring
- Join with a slip stitch

Round 2

Switch to **Goldenrod yarn**

- Work **2 double crochets (Dc)** into each stitch around
- You should have approximately **66 stitches**
- Join with slip stitch

Fasten off and weave in ends if needed

Part 2: Terracotta Lattice Border

Attach **Terracotta yarn**

- Work a combination of:
 - Single crochet (Sc)
 - Chains (Ch)
 - Picots (Ch 3, slip stitch into base)

Pattern Flow

- Create V-shaped sections using chain spaces
- Add picots at intervals for texture
- Continue around the mandala to form a triangular lace effect

This forms the decorative lower portion of the necklace ✨

Part 3: Integrated Tassels (Puff Stitches)

Now you'll create the signature teardrop tassels

How to Make Each Tassel

- Attach yarn at designated points along the edge
- Chain a few stitches for length
- Work a **puff stitch sequence**:
 - Yarn over, insert hook, pull up loop
 - Repeat 3 times
 - Yarn over and pull through all loops
- Chain 1 to secure

Repeat evenly across the bottom edge to create a row of tassels

Part 4: Neck Strap

Using **Terracotta yarn**

Step 1: Foundation

- Create a **chainless foundation row** or chain to desired strap length

Step 2: Build the Strap

- Work rows of **double crochet (Dc)** back and forth
- Keep edges straight and tension even

Step 3: Attach to Necklace

- Secure both ends of the strap to the top edges of the mandala
- Reinforce with extra stitches if needed

✨ Finishing Touches

Weave in Ends

Use a tapestry needle to neatly hide all loose yarn ends

Blocking

- Lightly dampen your necklace
- Shape it flat
- Let it dry completely

Adjust Tension

Ensure tassels hang evenly and the necklace sits comfortably

Optional Enhancements

- Add beads to tassels
- Use gradient yarn for color variation
- Adjust strap length for a choker or longer necklace
